

Volunteer Immunizations Required

As a volunteer, these tests are provided **FREE** of charge. You will not continue through the volunteer applicant process or start volunteering without being cleared by the Team Member Health and Wellbeing Department. Please allow 3-5 business days after your appointment to receive the next step in the process from a member of the Volunteer Services team.

All volunteers at The Christ Hospital Health Network are **required** to get the following:

- Blood draws for Measles, Mumps, Rubella and Varicella Titer
- Blood test for Tuberculosis status
- Flu vaccination (during flu season, October to April)
- T-Dap (whooping cough) vaccination

The COVID-19 Vaccine is strongly recommended.

Please bring your immunization records to the appointment.

If you are under the age of 18, you will need to be accompanied by a parent or guardian. At the date and time of your appointment, report to **Suite 234** in the Medical Office Building on the 2nd floor. Scheduling information will be provided after your interview.
